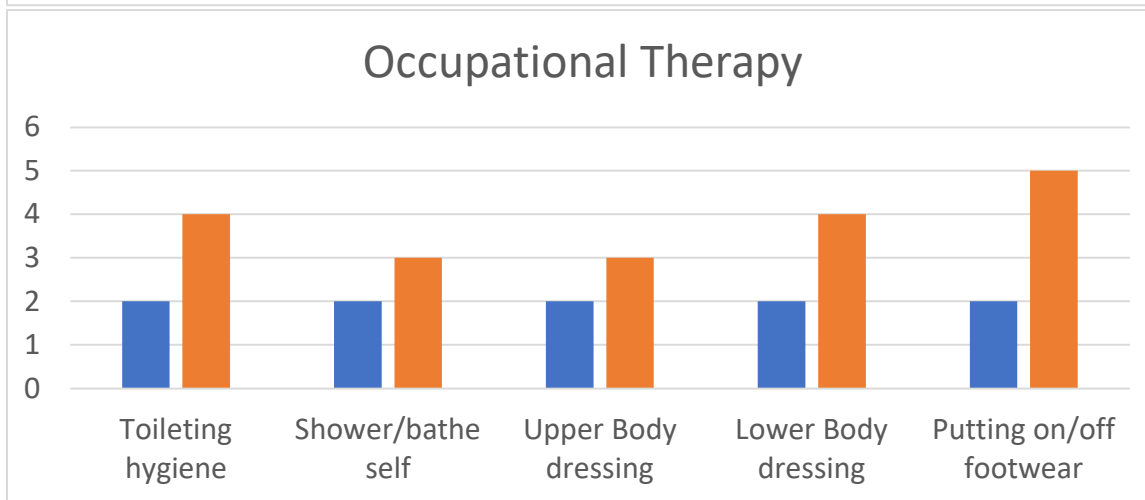
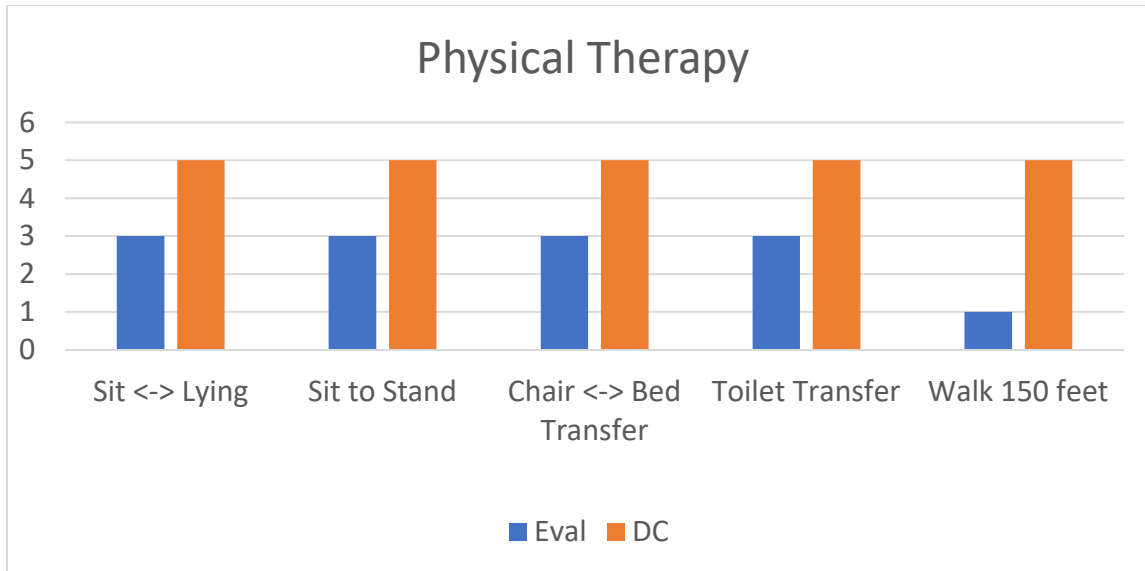


Mrs. Perry is an 81-year-old female who admitted to **Willowbrook Nursing & Rehabilitation Center** on 3/7/2024 from an acute care hospital after experiencing a fall at church with severe injury.

PT evaluated Mrs. Perry on 3/8/2024 where she was able to perform bed mobility and transfers with Contact Guard Assistance and used a single point cane to ambulate 150feet on even surfaces. Prior to her hospitalization, Mrs. Perry was Independent with all ADLs living with her husband. PT set goals to focus on improving his strength, functional transfers, balance, and functional mobility, with the goal of discharging to his home alone.

OT evaluated Mrs. Perry on 3/9/2024. She required Maximum assistance with performing upper-body dressing and grooming/hygiene while maintaining her shoulder precautions. She required Maximum Assistance during toileting tasks and ADL's. OT set goals to address increasing her ability to stand unsupported during ADL's and promote safety awareness during functional task performance, and also her safety during functional mobility and transfers with Modified Independence.

Following 29 days of skilled nursing and therapy services, Mrs. Perry made significant functional gains with PT and was able to perform all bed mobility and transfers with Modified Independence. She was able to ambulate **500+ ft** using a single-point cane. She made great gains with OT and is now able to complete Activities of Daily Living with Moderate to Minimal Assistance. Mrs. Perry was able to safely discharge with her husband to their home on 4/05/2024 with family support and home health of her choice.



MDS Section GG Functional Scores	
06 - Independent	Completes the activity by him/herself with no assistance from a helper
05- Setup or clean-up assistance	Helper sets up or cleans up; patient completes activity. Helper assists only prior to or following the activity.
04 - Supervision or touching assistance	Helper provides verbal cues and/or touching/steadying and/or contact guard assistance as patient completes activity. Assistance may be provided throughout the activity or intermittently.
03 - Partial/moderate assistance	Helper does LESS THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts, holds, or supports trunk or limbs but provides less than half the effort.
02 - Substantial/maximal assistance	Helper does MORE THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts or holds trunk or limbs and provides more than half the effort.
01 - Dependent	Helper does ALL of the effort. Patient does none of the effort to complete the activity. Or the assistance of two or more helpers is required for the patient to complete the activity.
